

## **L237 NYCHA MAINTENANCE WORKER JOB SURVEY**

A key demand in this contract is to provide maintenance workers with a higher rate of pay when performing out of title tasks usually done by skilled trade workers. The City and NYCHA have rejected this demand so we are proceeding to arbitration. THIS IS OUR OPPORTUNITY TO PROVE OUR CASE. We need to demonstrate to the arbitrator that this actually happens. That means that at least a majority of the 1,000 NYCHA maintenance workers need to indicate that they spend a percentage of their time doing this higher out of title work.

Think about it. The Union says the maintenance worker spends for example 10% of their time doing the job of a plumber. The arbitrator asks what our proof is - and our answer is that we surveyed 1,000 workers and 50 responded. The arbitrator will probably dismiss the case for lack of proof. We need way more than 50 answers.

We have attached a survey which the majority of you must file. IF WE DON'T DO AT LEAST THIS - WE LOSE.

The form is simple:

- During an average 40 hours a week that you work, check the box which represents the average number of hours spent doing the work of the trade indicated:
  - 1-5
  - 6-10
  - 11-15
  - 16-20
  - 21-25
  - 26-30
  - 31-35
  - 35-40

Please sign your name and work location and date. Give the completed form to your business agent who will be coming around to collect your surveys.
